







Installation - Clamping Arms






- 1. Offer up the profile with clamping arms folded in through the cutout pre-made in the ceiling. We Advise to have power feed be terminated into the gearbox at this point (see the wiring diagram on the next page).
- 2. Screw the brackets screw to fix the profile in place.

Installation - Spring Arms





- 1. Terminate the power feed to the luminaire gearbox (see the wiring diagram on the next page) and offer the luminaire up to the ceiling with the spring arms pulled back.
- 2. Feed the luminaire through the cutout pre-made in the ceiling. Ensure the spring arms open without obstruction and let the luminaire house its self into the cutout leaving the diffuser flush with the ceiling plane.
